Scholarships

The scholarships for attendance of the Doctoral Course have a duration of one year and are renewed for the second and third year of enrollment provided that the Doctoral student has completed the program of activities planned for the previous year, verified according to the procedures established by the Organizational Regulations of the Course, without prejudice to the obligation to disburse the scholarship following the successful completion of the verification. The amount of the scholarship, to be disbursed in monthly instalments, is determined in an amount equal to that provided for by Ministerial Decree 25 January 2018, n.40. The amount of the scholarship is increased, up to a maximum of 50% and compatibly with budget availability both for the resources allocated by the Central Administration and for those made available by the structures, for the performance of research activities abroad, following the authorization by the Board of Professors, for periods not exceeding a total of 18 months. This increase is paid at the end of the period of research activity abroad, upon presentation of a declaration by the person in charge of the institution that hosted the activities of the doctoral student, stating the period of time spent abroad. In cases of periods of activity abroad for a continuous duration of more than two months, at the request of the doctoral student accompanied by the declaration of the head of the institution hosting the activities of the doctoral student, the increase may be paid in monthly installments during the activity abroad. Starting from the second year, each doctoral student is guaranteed, in addition to the scholarship and within the financial resources allocated, funding for research activities in Italy and abroad, the amount of which is determined for each course to the extent of 10% of the gross annual amount by the institution, unless supplementary funding is provided from the operating fund of the department where the course is administered. The scholarship for the attendance of the Doctoral course is subject to the payment of social security contributions to INPS separate management scheme pursuant to Article 2, paragraph 26, of Law August 8, 1995, n.335 and subsequent amendments and additions, to the extent of two thirds borne by the Administration and one third borne by the scholarship holder. The scholarships financed by other universities or public or private entities may be tied to the development of specific research topics. Scholarships that provide for the carrying out of a specific research activity bind the assignees to carry out this activity and to comply with the provisions of the agreement. The Board of Professors is responsible for verifying that the abovementioned conditions are observed. For Doctoral courses established and activated as a result of cooperation agreements with foreign universities or research institutions of high qualification and international recognition, as per art. 10 of the D.M. 45/2013, the rules relating to scholarships will be defined in the agreements themselves. The rules referred to in this article do not apply to scholarship recipients from foreign countries or recipients of financial support as part of specific mobility programs, for which reference is made to the specific regulations. Scholarships for the attendance of doctoral courses may not be combined with other scholarships for any reason whatsoever, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions useful to integrate, with stays abroad, the training or research activities of the holders of the scholarships. Those who have already received, even partially, a scholarship for the attendance of a doctoral program at an Italian university may not receive another doctoral scholarship.

Contributions for access and attendance of the courses Upon enrollment

Doctoral students are required to pay the regional tax for the right to study and the stamp duty for a total amount equal to \in 156.00. Also those enrolled in the courses holding a research grant are required to pay the fee.
