

# Erasmus+ Call 2023/2024 Mobility for Study











The **Erasmus+ program** for study allows students to spend a period of study at a **European university**, holder of Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) and affiliated with the University of Perugia. The student has the opportunity to **follow courses**, **take exams**, **carry out thesis and traineeship**, with the guarantee of **full recognition** of the training activities carried out abroad with positive results, provided they are approved under the **Learning Agreement**.





# **Eligible countries**

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Iceland, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Norway, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, Hungary.





### **Mobility Period**

Students can spend their mobility period at our Partner Universities between **June the 1**st, **2023** and **July the 31**st, **2024**.

Erasmus students may request an extension of the period abroad from the Department Erasmus Delegate, subject to authorization from the host University, at least one month before the end of the initially planned mobility period.

The extension period cannot be extended beyond July the 31st, 2024.









Long-term mobility (long-term physical mobility) is intended for all students enrolled in a degree course, master's degree, single-cycle master's degree, doctoral courses, masters and specialization schools of the University. This type of mobility must have a minimum duration of 2 months and a maximum of 12 months and its duration is established by the inter-institutional agreement stipulated by the University of Perugia with the foreign university.










#### **SHORT-TERM PHYSICAL MOBILITY**

Short-term physical mobility is introduced with the new Erasmus+ 2021-2027 Programme. This type of mobility must have a duration of between 5 and 30 days and must always be accompanied by a period of virtual mobility, with the exception of the mobility of doctoral students for whom the period of virtual mobility is not mandatory.



# **Types of Mobility**





- There is no minimum duration for the virtual component of the mobility;
- For the virtual part, which must be carried out in the country in which the participants' home university
  is located, no financial contribution will be recognized;
- The possibility of carrying out a mixed mobility must be agreed with the host institution.





## Duration of physical mobility in case of blended mobility

- Between 5 and 30 days short-term physical mobility for candidates enrolled in a degree course, master's degree, single-cycle master's degree, master's and specialization schools. Admissible only in cases where candidates, for serious and proven health, personal, academic or professional reasons, cannot travel abroad for long periods; these need to be detailed in the specifically dedicated section of the online application and must be examined by the Erasmus Commission of the Department;
- **Between 2 and 12 months** long-term physical mobility <u>always eligible</u> for candidates enrolled in three-year degree courses, master's degree and single-cycle master's degree courses, specialization schools and doctorates, I and II level.





# Requirements for participation

- a) Being regularly enrolled at the Università degli Studi di Perugia in the current academic year;
- b) Have adequate **knowledge of the foreign language**, as required by the host university;
- c) Provide for the renewal of enrollment at the University of Perugia for the A.Y. 2023/2024;
- d) Having not benefit, in the same period of Erasmus+ study mobility, from a community contribution provided by other mobility programs financed with community funds.





The **status of student** enrolled in a study course at the University of Perugia must be maintained for the entire duration of the Erasmus+ study period.

The achievement of the degree or qualification required by one's course, before or during the period of study abroad, entails the forfeiture of the Erasmus contribution and the obligation to repay the funding received.






### **Compatibility with previous Erasmus+ experiences**

Students who have already completed a period of study or internship within the Erasmus+ Program can apply under the following conditions:

- a) If enrolled in the same study cycle in which they carried out the Erasmus+ mobility, the total duration of the mobility must not exceed 12 months including the months already completed (24 in the case of a single-cycle master's degree);
- b) If enrolled in a study cycle other than the one in which they carried out the Erasmus+ mobility, the total duration of the mobility must not exceed 12 months (24 in the case of a single-cycle master's degree), without including those months already completed in the cycle of previous studies.





### Study abroad programme

The study activity for the mobility period is agreed, before departure, with the home university and with the foreign university through the Learning Agreement, which indicates the educational activities that the student will carry out at the partner university.





### Language skills

In the application, candidates must indicate their **level of knowledge of the language of the host country or of the target language**, which will constitute an element of assessment by the Commission, as required by Article 10.





### Language skills

#### Evaluation object:

- a) Level tests taken at the CLA UNIPG (last two years);
- b) International language certifications validated by the CLA UNIPG https://cla.unipg.it/certificazioni-internazionali/riconoscimento-certificazioni (no more than three years);
- c) Foreign language proficiency tests organized by the CLA and taken remotely (without certificate, last two years);
- d) Tests of knowledge of the English language taken, from 10/1/2022, in Test basic English B1 mode;
- e) Passed language exam within one's course (last two years);
- f) "Placement tests" issued by EU/Academy (Online Linguistic Support OLS).





### **Mobility Grants**

The Erasmus+ for Study call provides for **funding** assigned exclusively **for carrying out eligible activities abroad**:

- Contribution from the European Union, only in the case of physical mobility (short and long term);
- European Union contribution for students with fewer opportunities;
- Additional monthly contribution paid by the University (50% of the contribution paid by the EU);
- Flat-rate contribution paid by the University for travel;
- Additional bonus contribution paid by the University (achievement of a minimum number of credits);
- Integration of the European Union contribution financed by the MUR (current or non-current students for no more than a year);
- Possible monthly supplement from A.Di.S.U.;
- Grant for students with special needs

### **Additional Contributions - Students with special needs**

Students with special needs in mobility can request an additional contribution from the **Erasmus+ National Agency INDIRE** through the International Relations Area of the University of Perugia.

The University provides an additional monthly contribution of € 500.00 for mobility students with a disability equal to or greater than 66% and/or in a handicap situation (Article 3, paragraph 1 and/or paragraph 3, Law 104/92), as extrapolated from the ESSE3 system.

NB: The aforementioned contribution from the University will be paid only in the case of physical mobility and, in the case of blended mobility, only for the period actually spent at the host institution.

# Deadlines for submitting the application

- <u>first deadline:</u> **11 April 2023,** 12:00
- <u>second deadline</u>: **15 June 2023,** 12:00 (only for residual destinations not assigned for the first deadline and only for mobility to be carried out in the second semester).





# Deadlines for submitting the application

After the deadline of April 11<sup>th</sup>2023, the Attachment "List of partner universities and mobility flows" to this call will be reformulated with the remaining destinations (not assigned in the first deadline) and with any additional destinations (on the basis of new signed agreements). For the second deadline of June 15<sup>th</sup> 2023 at 12:00, the application form will be available starting from May 15<sup>th</sup> 2023.





### **Selection criteria**

Candidates are selected by the Erasmus Commission of the Department.

The selection of students for bachelor's, single-cycle, master's and master's degree programs is carried out according to the following criteria:

- a. total number of credits acquired at the date of submission of the application form;
- **b.** average of the marks of all the exams passed by the student at the date of submission of the application and, for students enrolled in master's degree courses, marks obtained in the first level degree;
- c. language skills;
- **d. description of the study project** that the student intends to carry out at the chosen university campuses and of the relative congruence with his or her study path at the university.





### **Selection Criteria**

The selection of **students enrolled in the doctorate and in the specialization school** takes place on the basis of the following criteria:

- a. number of academic years used by the student to complete the course of study necessary for access to the doctorate or specialization school in relation to the years foreseen;
- **b.** degree mark obtained by the student in the study courses already completed and marks obtained in the exams if present in the doctoral course or in the specialization school to which he/she belongs;
- c. language skills;
- **d. description of the study or research project** that the student intends to carry out at the chosen university locations and of the relative congruence with his or her study or research path at the university.
